

ITT Developmental Review and PCR 2015 Legislative Guidance

CHALLENGE

Our client was a not-for-profit charity within the education sector who had a long-standing critical contract for specialist services, worth half a million pounds, that was nearing its expiration date.

In line with the requirements of the Public Contracts Regulations 2015, the client recognised that they needed to procure a new contract which satisfied the EU procurement directives, however they lacked the in-house procurement knowledge and technical expertise to do this.

SOLUTION
